



Last Minute Risk Assessment (LMRA)

- ✓ Is the work well prepared?
- ✓ Have I received sufficient instructions?
- ✓ Is the workplace tidy and clean?
- ✓ Can I carry out my work in a safe manner?
- ✓ Are the tools safe and certified?
- ✓ Are my personal protective equipment (PPE) in good condition?
- ✓ Do I know where the escape routes are, and are they free of obstacles?

**Only if I can answer “yes” to all of the above questions, I can start my work safely.
If in doubt, I consult my supervisor.**

Safety Behaviour Rules

BanBouw wants everyone to work in a safe, healthy and pleasant environment!
To achieve this, it is important that we apply the following safety behaviour rules:

- ✓ We always perform an LMRA before starting any work.
- ✓ We only perform tasks for which we are qualified.
- ✓ We always use suitable and approved tools and equipment.
- ✓ We use the correct and appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).
- ✓ We keep our workplace clean, tidy and safe.
- ✓ We address unsafe behaviour and accept feedback.
- ✓ We take immediate action in case of unsafe situations and report them.
- ✓ We take precautions to work safely at heights.
- ✓ We never work under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication that impairs our reaction time.
- ✓ We stay alert and keep an eye on our surroundings.

- ✓ I am registered and my presence is known.

Smoking only allowed in designated areas

Certified safety helmet



High-visibility upper clothing



Hearing protection for work $\geq$ 80 dB



Eye protection when there is a risk of eye injury



Safety gloves when there is a risk of hand injury



Dust mask $\geq$ P2 when exposed to fine dust
